By order issued April 11, 2008 (FCC 08-100), the Commission designated TracFone Wireless, Inc. as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) pursuant to Section 214(e)(6) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, to receive Universal Service Fund support to provide Lifeline service in the states of New York, Virginia, Connecticut, Massachusetts, Alabama, North Carolina, Tennessee, Delaware, New Hampshire, and the District of Columbia.

Those ETC designations are subject to certain conditions, including a condition set forth at paragraph 16 of the aforementioned order that TracFone certify that it is in full compliance with any applicable 911/E911 obligations, including obligations relating to provision and support of 911 and E911 service. By this letter, TracFone certifies that it is in compliance with the applicable laws of the State of Delaware.


