

The provider to my development, BrightHouse Networks, holds a 10 year exclusive, bulk-billed CONTRACT (contrary to BHN ads). In one particular ad, BHN touts the slogan "It's all about YOU!".

Let's see if that is true:

1. I do not have a choice -- I must pay BrightHouse.
2. The blind and deaf do not have a choice -- they must pay BrightHouse.
3. Active military cannot cancel service while deployed -- they must pay BrightHouse.
4. If a house is foreclosed the cable bill must be paid -- I must pay BrightHouse.
5. If a house is abandoned the cable bill must be paid -- I must pay BrightHouse.
6. If a house burns down the cable bill (probably) must be paid -- I must pay BrightHouse.
7. If neighbors do not pay their HOA dues the cable bill must be paid -- I must pay BrightHouse.
8. If it comes down to buying food or paying the cable bill, the cable bill must be paid -- I must pay BrightHouse.

So I cannot cancel service and I must pay extra for empty houses.

This "NO LONG TERM CONTRACT TO SIGN" Contract seems to be all about BrightHouse if you ask me.
