As required under Section 27.20 of the Commission's rules, Cable Montana, L.L.C. ("Cable Montana") hereby submits its first quarter report required under the Commission's DIV consumer education initiative.¹

Cable Montana was the winning bidder for one Lower 700 MHz B Block license in Auction 73. The Commission granted this license – Call Sign WQIZ387 (Lincoln, NE Cellular Market Area) – to Cable Montana on June 26, 2008.²

Cable Montana hereby reports that it has undertaken no outreach efforts to date to educate consumers about the transition from analog broadcast television service to digital broadcast television.
