Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 2, 2009, I spoke with Nick Alexander regarding the above-captioned proceedings. On behalf of Comcast, I urged the Commission to act promptly to reduce the porting interval in the pending local number porting (LNP) rulemaking. Specifically, I urged the Commission to adopt Comcast's proposal to reduce the standard interval for simple ports to next day for providers that employ electronically bonded (e-bonded) porting solutions and to two days for providers that do not employ such solutions.<sup>1</sup> In addition to striking the proper balance between e-bonded and non-e-bonded carriers, Comcast's proposal also would benefit consumers by enabling them to change voice providers quickly and efficiently, thereby intensifying competition among providers of voice service.

Pursuant to the Commission's rules, this letter is being submitted for inclusion in the public record of the above-referenced proceedings.
