Ligtel Communications, Inc. (“Ligtel”) is the licensee of Station WQIZ573 (CMA404 – Channel Block B) in the 698-806 MHz Band (“700 MHz Band”). Our Auction 73 long-form application was recently granted by the Commission. See *Public Notice*, entitled “Wireless Telecommunications Bureau Grants 700 MHz Band Licenses,” DA 08-1522, Report No. AUC-73 (Auction No. 73), dated June 26, 2008.

Pursuant to Section 27.20 of the Commission’s Rules, we hereby report that for the quarter ended December 31, 2008, Ligtel has undertaken the following outreach efforts to educate consumers about the transition from analog broadcast television service to digital broadcast television service (“DTV”):

Ligtel has sent out one bill stuffer to educate consumers about the transition and the delay of the transition date to DTV and it is including a printed DTV transition notice in its customers’ monthly bills.

Ligtel is a Multichannel Video Programming Distributor (“MVPD”) that provides IPTV services to consumers in the State of Indiana. We note that we have not yet had an opportunity to acquire equipment or to deploy services under our new 700 MHz license.
