NINTH CONSOLIDATED STATUS REPORT
OF INTRADO COMMUNICATIONS OF VIRGINIA INC.

Intrado Communications of Virginia Inc. ("Intrado Comm"), by its attorneys, respectfully submits this Ninth Consolidated Status Report in response to the request from staff of the Wireline Competition Bureau ("Bureau") of the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission" or "FCC"). This report provides information regarding the status of negotiations between Intrado Comm and Central Telephone Company of Virginia and United Telephone - Southeast, Inc. (collectively, "Embarq"), including the status of other state arbitration proceedings pending between Intrado Comm and Embarq. There have been no further regulatory developments regarding the Intrado Comm/Embarq arbitrations since the Eighth

Consolidated Status Report. The Parties are negotiating a 251(a) interconnection agreement pursuant to the Order of the Florida Public Service Commission.¹

This report also provides information regarding the status of negotiations between Intrado Comm and Verizon South Inc. and Verizon Virginia Inc. (collectively, “Verizon”), including the status of other state arbitration proceedings pending between Intrado Comm and Verizon. The following has occurred since Intrado Comm’s Eighth Consolidated Status Report filed March 26, 2009:

Florida - On December 16, 2008, Verizon filed a Motion for Final Summary Order in the Intrado Comm/Verizon Florida arbitration proceeding (Attachment 2 to Second Consolidated Status Report). On March 20, 2009, the Florida commission issued an order directing Intrado Comm to file a response to Verizon’s Motion by March 27, 2009. (Attachment 7 to Eighth Consolidated Status Report). A copy Intrado Comm’s Response to Verizon Motion for Final Order is set forth in **Attachment 1**. On March 27, 2009, the Florida commission issued an Order Modifying Procedure, which set the procedural schedule for the Intrado Comm/Verizon Florida arbitration proceeding, which is set forth in **Attachment 2**.

Maryland - On April 9, 2009, the Hearing Examiner issued a Scheduling Notice stating that it will refrain from issuing a Proposed Order in the Intrado Comm/Verizon arbitration until the Federal Communications Commission issues its decision in this consolidated arbitration, which is set forth in **Attachment 3**.

Massachusetts - On April 6, 2009, at the request of Massachusetts commission staff, Intrado Comm and Verizon filed a Joint Motion Concerning Deadline for Arbitration Decision to extend the date for the commission staff's order in the arbitration until May 8, 2009, which is set forth in **Attachment 4**.
