

Hello,

Please look at the internet market in Alaska. Here in Anchorage (which has about 50% of the state's population), our options are very limited and expensive. For basic phone/internet DSL service I pay over \$85/month for 1Mbps/320. While a 3MB down line is "available" only one provider can supply it and it's about \$160/month once you add in everything required to get that speed.

Please look at Alaska, our cable and telecommunications companies have a monopoly and our speeds and pricing are way off!! They also haven't changed the pricing and offerings for many years.

In the Anchorage area the two main ISPs are Alaska Communication Systems (ACS), providing phone and DSL, and General Communication Inc. (GCI), providing cable TV and internet.
