Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 13, 2009, Bob Baker, President and COO of Vizada Americas and Barbara Spencer, General Counsel of Vizada Americas, along with Peter Rohrbach and David Saylor of Hogan & Hartson, counsel to Vizada, met with Jim Bird, Neil Dellar and Joel Rabinovitz of the Office of General Counsel.

During the meeting Vizada discussed the materials and arguments it previously provided in this docket. Vizada explained why, prior to the closing of Inmarsat's acquisition of Stratos and before the status quo changes, it is necessary and desirable for the Commission to obtain key data and documents from the parties to evaluate their claims regarding market definition, market power, competitive effects, and associated public interest matters. Vizada explained that the Commission has full procedural and substantive authority to ensure that the needed factual investigation and analysis can be conducted and completed before the status quo changes and the transaction is closed.
