REQUEST TO WITHDRAW

**PETITION OF WARWICK VALLEY MOBILE TELEPHONE COMPANY, INC. D/B/A
WVT BUSINESS COMMUNICATIONS FOR WAIVER OF THE ADVANCE
NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS OF 47 C.F.R. § 64.1120(e)**

On March 20, 2009, Warwick Valley Mobile Telephone Company, Inc. d/b/a WVT Business Communications (“Warwick”) filed the above-referenced petition (the “Petition”) requesting that the Commission grant Warwick a waiver of the 30-day advance notice requirement in 47 C.F.R. § 64.1120(e) so that Warwick may provide wholesale telecommunications services to the customers of USD CLEC, Inc. a/k/a USA Datanet, Debtor-in-Possession (“USA Datanet,” and together with Warwick, “Petitioners”) who do not select a new wholesale service provider prior to April 1, 2009. The Petitioners hereby request to withdraw the Petition.

Upon further examination of the nature of the USA Datanet customers to be acquired, and after consultation with Commission Staff, the Petitioners determined that the Petition is unnecessary as end user customers are not affected by the transaction. The USA Datanet customers are wholesale carriers only. Therefore, Warwick respectfully requests to withdraw its Petition.
