This letter will notify the Commission that on April 14, 2009, Richard Lynch, Executive Vice President and Chief Technical Officer of Verizon, Bill Stone, Executive Director-Technology, and I met with Acting Chairman Copps and his Interim Legal Advisor, Paul Murray, to discuss Verizon Wireless' deployment of 4G services using LTE technology in the 700 MHz band. In the course of that discussion, we urged the Commission to act promptly in the above-referenced proceeding to take steps to clear operation of wireless microphones and other LPAS devices from the 700 MHz band. Our statements were consistent with Verizon Wireless' previous filings in this proceeding.
