This letter will notify the Commission that on April 14, 2009, Richard Lynch, Executive Vice President and Chief Technical Officer of Verizon, Bill Stone, Executive Director-Technology, and I met with James Schlichting, Acting Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and the following staff of the Bureau: Monica Delong, Thomas Derenge, David Hu, Chris Moore, Matt Nodine, Blaise Scinto, Walt Strack, and Joel Taubenblatt. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss Verizon Wireless' plans for deployment of 4G services using LTE technology in the 700 MHz band. In the course of that discussion, we urged that the Commission act promptly in the above-referenced proceeding to clear unlicensed wireless microphones as well as licensed LPAS devices from the 700 MHz band because of the risks of harmful interference that will otherwise occur to those devices, wireless carriers' operations and public safety operations in the band. Our statements were consistent with Verizon Wireless' previous filings in this proceeding.
