MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §1.46, Public Knowledge, on behalf of the Ad Hoc Public Interest Spectrum Coalition,¹ respectfully requests a 10-day extension for the filing of oppositions and replies to those oppositions in the petition for reconsideration of the above-captioned rulemaking. The current deadline for filing oppositions is April 28, 2009, with replies to the oppositions due 10 days after that.

Public Knowledge requests this extension because the time period set aside for opposition and replies falls during the holiday of Passover, during which the counsel and staff of Respondents will be out of the office. Grant of a 10-day extension for filing and replies will give both Petitioners and Respondents adequate time to prepare and file oppositions and replies and observe the holiday.
