There are two pending requests for documents filed on March 6<sup>th</sup> and March 10<sup>th</sup> by NFL Enterprises and Comcast Cable Communications. There has been a completed round of pleadings filed as of March 31, 2009, including replies and surreplies. Also, at the Admissions Sessions held on April 13, 2009, the subject matter of the requests were discussed. Finally, with hearing commencing, time is of the essence.


Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that NFL Enterprises shall produce forthwith adequate representative documents related to negotiation and contracting with regard to licensing of "Sunday Ticket" and "Red Zone Channel".

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Comcast Cable Communications shall produce forth with adequate representative agreements with independent sports networks that may demonstrate that Comcast does not carry independent sports networks outside of its Sports Entertainment Tier.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that there is a possible need for additional documents, and so this *Order* may be amended from the bench as needed.
