Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter will notify the Commission that on Thursday, April 23, 2009, Andre Lachance of Verizon Wireless and Scott Delacourt and Helgi Walker, both of Wiley Rein LLP, met with Acting General Counsel Michele Ellison, Jim Bird, and Neil Dellar, all of the Office of General Counsel, to discuss roaming issues raised in a recent *ex parte* letter filed by Leap Wireless in this proceeding.¹ The discussion was consistent with prior arguments that Alltel and Verizon Wireless made in their December 22, 2008 Joint Opposition to Petitions for Reconsideration and most recently in Verizon Wireless's April 10, 2009 *ex parte* letter² as to why Leap's Petition for Clarification or Reconsideration is without merit. Verizon Wireless and its counsel further explained that the November 4, 2008 Order approving the Verizon Wireless-Alltel merger³ expressly considered and rejected the argument Leap now makes about the scope of the roaming conditions.
