Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, Tom Sugrue, Kathleen O'Brien Ham, Amy Wolverton, and the undersigned of T-Mobile USA, Inc. had a discussion with Commissioner Robert M. McDowell and his Chief of Staff, Angela E. Giancarlo about the above-referenced proceedings, consistent with T-Mobile's previous filings in the dockets. The T-Mobile representatives urged the Commission to repeal the roaming "in-market exclusion," and explained that basing the right to roaming on whether the requesting carrier has spectrum rights in the area hampers competition and undermines consumer expectations. Regarding special access, we described the lack of competition in the critical market for high-capacity special access services and how unreasonable rates, terms, and conditions imposed by large incumbent local exchange carriers hinder the deployment of broadband services.
