This letter is to inform you that as of April 15, 2009, Verizon has reached 100 percent compliance for offering E911 capability to the customers of Verizon's interconnected VoIP services.

Verizon Voice over IP

As previously explained, Verizon provides E911 capability to all of its two-way interconnected Verizon Voice over IP customers at their fixed locations and as of November 28, 2005 is only adding new customers to this service in areas where Verizon can provide 911 services that comply with FCC rules.

Verizon VoiceWing

As we previously informed you, Verizon's VoiceWing service has been discontinued as of April 15, 2009. As such, we no longer have any "grandfathered" customers.

Because we have achieved 100 percent compliance for offering E911 capability to the customers of Verizon's interconnected VoIP services, we do not intend to continue filing monthly status updates with the Commission unless the Commission notifies us that it would like to continue receiving such updates.
