
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 30, 2009, Doug Brandon and David LaFrance of TerreStar Networks Inc. ("TerreStar") and the undersigned, counsel to TerreStar, met with Julius Knapp, Alan Stillwell, Bruce Romano, Geraldine Matise, and Nicholas Oros of the Office of Engineering and Technology concerning the above-referenced proceedings.
