Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 4, 2009, Lauren Van Wazer, Chief Policy and Technology Counsel, and the undersigned, both from Cox Enterprises, Inc., met with Nicholas Alexander, Legal Advisor on wireline matters to Commissioner McDowell. On May 5, 2009, we met separately with Mark Stone, Legal Advisor on wireline matters to Commissioner Adelstein, and with Jennifer Schneider, Broadband, Wireline, and Universal Service Legal Advisor to Acting Chairman Copps.

At the meetings, we expressed our strong support for a 48-hour maximum interval for simple number ports. The Commission's record indicates that the industry is capable of completing simple ports in this timeframe, and there is no reason to further delay the adoption of this requirement. We also urged the Commission to limit its consideration in the upcoming Order to the porting interval and related administrative issues.
