On Friday, May 8, 2009, Robert Quinn and I, both representing AT&T, spoke with or left messages for Rick Chessen and Paul Murray of Chairman Copps' Office, Renee Crittendon of Commissioner Adelstein's Office, Angela Giancarlo of Commissioner McDowell's Office and Jim Schlichting, Chris Moore, Susan Singer and Monica DeLong of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. The purpose of the communications was to provide information regarding AT&T's intent to sell certain Centennial Communications Corp. assets to Verizon Wireless, as detailed in the attached News Release. The sale is contingent upon regulatory approval of the underlying transaction. We noted that the proposed divestitures should address many of the regulatory issues being reviewed in this proceeding.
