Dear Ms. Dortch,

On Friday, May 15, 2009, Joan Marsh, of AT&T, Peter Schildkraut, William Cook and Will Mudge of Arnold & Porter, representing AT&T and Jonathan Cohen of Wilkinson, Barker and Knauer, representing Centennial Communications, spoke with Erin McGrath and Susan Singer of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Neil Dellar and Joel Rabinovitz of the Office of the General Counsel. The purpose of the discussion was to provide information regarding the Applicants' request for heightened or second level protection of certain categories of highly sensitive competitive information that has been requested by the FCC in the General Information Requests received by the Applicants on April 30, 2009. The Applicants agreed to file a separate letter outlining their requests for heightened protection and the reasons why such protection is appropriate.

We also advised Staff that a large volume of information responsive to the Information Requests needed to be shared between the Applicants and subjected to joint review and that some software incompatibilities and difficulties with mapping software slowed the Applicants' ability to complete their final review of the information to be submitted. Applicants also requested resolution of all pending protective order issues before submitting any highly confidential materials to the FCC to ensure that the appropriate protection was provided the information as filed. As such, Applicants requested that they be given until Tuesday, May 19, 2009 to provide written responses and supporting documentation to the April 30 General Information Requests.
