On Tuesday, May 19, 2009, Jeanine Poltronieri of AT&T, Peter Schildkraut, William Cook and Maureen Jeffreys of Arnold & Porter LLP, representing AT&T, and Jonathan Cohen and Larry Movshin of Wilkinson Barker Knauer, LLP, representing Centennial Communications, spoke with Erin McGrath of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Jim Bird, Neil Dellar, Virginia Metallo and Joel Rabinovitz of the Office of the General Counsel. We discussed Applicants' May 18, 2009 Request for a Second Protective Order in the above-referenced proceeding to provide heightened or second level protection of certain categories of highly sensitive competitive information that has been requested by the FCC in the General Information Requests received by Applicants on April 30, 2009.

Applicants requested resolution of all pending protective order issues before submitting any highly confidential materials to the FCC to ensure that the appropriate protection will be provided the information as filed. Accordingly, Applicants requested that they be given until one business day following the date of the release of the Second Protective Order to provide written responses to the April 30 General Information Requests and supporting documentation.
