*Pursuant* to 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b), I am electronically providing this notice of an *ex parte* communication to report that I, counsel to iClick2Media, Inc. and AlphaStar International Inc, along with Malik Shakur, President of iClick2Media; Manjari Prakash, advisor to iClick2Media and Michael Wahba, president of AlphaStar International Inc. spoke via teleconference on May 18, 2009 with counsel to Acting Chairman Copps, Jamila-Bess Johnson and Rick Chessen. The next day, on May 19, 2009, Mr. Shakur and I spoke with counsel for media issues to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein, Rudy Brioche.

During both calls, the positions and concerns expressed by iClick2Media and AlphaStar on the record in written comments and documents on the docket were reiterated. Most notably, the parties urged the Commission to implement the set-aside in a manner that is mindful of small independent content producers, many of whom may have been unable to, or have tried and failed to engage Sirius XM in carriage negotiations because of their lack of influence, counsel or other reasons. Given the fact that the merger created a monopoly situation, eliminating choice of programmers, iClick2Media and AlphaStar urged that the Commission staffers to adopt an approach that would enable the most amounts of content suppliers to gain carriage as possible. The venture iClick2Media and AlphaStar propose to engage, American Independent Radio, is proposing to eliminate roadblocks to carriage for small content producers, many of whom who have been unsuccessful in reaching mass markets of radio listeners, via satellite or terrestrial radio.
