Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is to inform you that on May 21, 2009, Sprint Nextel Corporation (“Sprint Nextel”) through its representatives Charles W. McKee (Vice President, Federal and State Regulatory, Government Affairs) and Maria Cattafesta (Senior Counsel, Government Affairs), met with Chris Moore (Deputy Chief, Office of the Bureau Chief), Erin McGrath (Assistant Chief, Mobility Division), Susan Singer (Associate Chief, Spectrum and Competition Policy Division), Stacy Ferraro (Attorney-Advisor), David Goldman (Attorney-Advisor) and T. David Hu (Legal Advisor, Office of the Bureau Chief) of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau to discuss the above-captioned proceeding.

Sprint Nextel expressed its concern about the current lack of information regarding AT&T’s plans for Centennial’s CDMA network in Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands and the potential impact of those plans on Centennial’s CDMA customers and roaming partners. In addition, Sprint Nextel suggested that the Commission require AT&T to honor Centennial’s existing CDMA roaming agreements in their entirety and maintain the Centennial CDMA network for a reasonable period of time, similar to what the Commission required of Verizon with respect to ALLTEL’s GSM network in the Verizon/ALLTEL proceeding.
