

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 29, 2009, Mr. Lyman Horne of Star Telephone Membership Cooperative of Clinton, North Carolina, spoke to Ms. Jennifer McKee, Acting Chief of the Telecommunications Access Division of the Commission's Wireline Competition Bureau. Mr. Horne also left voice mail messages for Mr. Alexander, Legal Advisor to Commissioner McDowell, Ms. Schneider, Legal Advisor to Chairman Copps and Mr. Stone, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Adelstein. In his communications, Mr. Horne stressed the urgent need to remedy the discrimination in calculating Local Switching Support for certain small rural local exchanges carriers, such as Star, that the rule change adopted in the Commission's Report and Order released recently in CC Docket No. 80-286 will extend for another year.¹
