I am writing on behalf of L-3 Communications SafeView, Inc. ("L-3 SafeView"), formerly known as SafeView, Inc.

A list of current L-3 SafeView installations is attached. We can provide exact street addresses or coordinates for any of the U.S. locations. The data on overseas units reflect the best information available to the company, but overseas units may have been moved without the company's knowledge.

Pursuant to Section 0.459 of the Commission's Rules, L-3 SafeView requests that the attachment be withheld from public inspection on the ground that its disclosure would burden L-3 SafeView with an unfair competitive disadvantage.

L-3 SafeView has not received any reports of interference due to the operation of its products.
