

My 3 children currently ride on a bus in Cobb county which plays Bus radio. There are commercials and songs or artists on this radio that I DO NOT approve of or play in my own car or home. I am almost to the point that I will drive my own kids to school if need be. As a taxpayer, I should not have to feel that way about my child's transportation to school.

I am very concerned that our government allows this on it's school buses.

Commercial radio broadcasts designed for school buses are not in the public interest. I do not want my child – or any child – to be forced to listen to student-targeted advertising on their way to and from school. Services such as BusRadio undermine my ability to monitor my child's exposure to media and marketing messages. I am particularly troubled that BusRadio routinely plays songs from albums that come with parental warnings and advertises products that undermine children's well-being and education.

I monitor and limit all of the media in my own home. I should not be made to feel that I can't monitor or control their ride to school.
