

Dear Chief Furth:

NPSPAC Region 28 RPC respectfully requests a 30 day extension from the Commission. The extra 30 days is necessary to complete the copulation of all of the old records in an effort to complete our assignment matrix of all licensed NPSPC spectrum which has been allocated by the RPC and licensed over the past 19 years since our Region 28 Plan was approved by the Commission on February 2, 1990.

Region 28 RPC will have a completed and amended plan with letters of concurrence from the five adjacent NPSPAC regions within the 30 day extension period, which will be no later than July 10, 2009. The completed Non-Streamlined Plan Amendment will be filed electronically.
