

I strongly urge the FCC to reverse the foundational mistake of its broadband policy framework by reclassifying broadband as a telecommunications service. This would allow the FCC to prevent monopolies and oligopolies in broadband internet providers and allow natural and healthy competition to increase the quality and speed of service, as well as lowering prices and expanding network coverage.

Additionally, the FCC should seek to create internet neutrality regulations. The best-effort packet routing principle fosters online competition and allows Americans to fairly choose online content without a bias in quality of service, which would artificially increase the attractiveness of an online content provider.
