

Comcast Cable in New Jersey is charging \$6 charge HDTV digital converter and under their "Digital Classic package for \$16.95" they've bundled or included a \$3.40 charge for 1 Digital Converter. I was told the HDTV digital converter is for the signal not the converter box. They look like the same charge. I should only be charged for one converter not 2 separate ones. The \$6 charge for HDTV should include the \$3.40 for the plain digital converter.

Also the charge for the converter ought to include the remote--why are we nickel and dimed and charge .25 every month for equipment that should be part of the "package".

If this were a medical bill it would be called double dipping and under Medicare rules and regulations would be subject to fines and/or jail time. Similar laws ought to be enacted to prevent the double dipping practices of utility companies.
