Dear Mr. Chandler

Further to the request issued by the National Exchange Carriers Association (NECA) on June 9, 2009, this letter is to provide your office with the percentage of calls currently placed through CSDVRS using a ten-digit number pursuant to the 2008 numbering orders.

Thus far in 2009, video relay service (VRS) calls originating from a videophone with a local number have increased from 15% in January to 37.8% in May. As you can see, although there is a cognizable increase, there still remains a significant lag in the use of ten-digit numbers despite the outreach efforts of VRS providers.
