Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of AT&T, this letter responds to the June 9, 2009 data request from the National Exchange Carriers Association. The data request asked each VRS and IP Relay provider to provide the percentage of calls currently placed using a ten-digit number issued pursuant to the 2008 numbering orders (as opposed to being placed by persons without such a number or using a proxy number).

Our data for IP Relay calls for the period June 5 through June 11, 2009 reflects that 6.6% of calls for this period were originated by registered users with a ten-digit number, and 3.78% of all minutes for this period were originated by users with a ten-digit number.

Additionally, our data for VRS calls, provided by our VRS vendor, reflects that between May 31 and June 6, 2009, 4% of all VRS calls for this period were originated by registered users with a ten-digit number, and 23% of all minutes for this same period were generated by users with a ten-digit number.

We are unable to determine at this time what percentage of users who dialed around and used AT&T services may have a 10-digit number with another provider.
