Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 10, 2009, Carla Anderson of e-Copernicus met with David Furth of the Public Safety Bureau concerning the above-captioned proceedings. Sree Tangella of New EA, Inc. dba Flow Mobile and Gregory L. Rohde of e-Copernicus joined the meeting by conference call

During the meeting, we discussed a proposal to re-auction the D-Block as soon as possible for dual use with public safety and commercial service. New EA described its 4G technology and the need for an interoperable public safety network based on open standards and one that accommodates all technologies, including LTE. We also stressed that the FCC should entertain petitions for early build out of 700 MHz public safety spectrum already licensed.

We also discussed hosting a demonstration of New EA's wireless base stations, the scope and length of the demonstration, and the technology and spectrum proposed for use. We also noted New EA's STA filing and proposed dates for the testing. (Current bands and future bands).

The attached presentation and letters of support from North Dakota Governor John Hoeven and the Dakota Chapter of NENA were distributed during the meeting both meetings.
