The Public Safety Spectrum Trust Corporation ("PSST") hereby provides notice of a permitted *ex parte* communication. On June 17, 2009, Chief Harlin R. McEwen, Chairman of the PSST, and Michele Farquhar of Hogan & Hartson LLP, counsel to the PSST, met with David Furth, Acting Chief; Jeff Cohen, Acting Deputy Chief; and Carol Simpson, Acting Associate Bureau Chief; all of the Commission's Public Safety & Homeland Security Bureau ("PSHSB"), as well as David Horowitz and Christopher Killion of the Commission's Office of General Counsel.

The primary purpose of the brief meeting was to note the PSST's possible interest in filing a grant application with the NTIA's Broadband Technology Opportunities Program to fund the clearing of narrowband public safety users from the 700 MHz public safety channels now designated for broadband use. Clearing these users is a necessary first step to facilitating access to and use of the public safety broadband spectrum. The PSST representatives also confirmed their interest in coordinating with the Commission before filing any such application.
