Request for Review

Dear Ms. Dortch,

SchoolFusion is a Web Hosting and communications service provider to school districts participating in the E-Rate program through USAC. We are writing to appeal a decision made by USAC on May 22nd 2009 regarding our cost allocation percentage for web hosting services.

Currently, SchoolFusion has allocated 5% of our solution as "User Account Management aligned with permissions and account security" which, at the time of allocation creation, was deemed ineligible.

In April of this year, we understood from USAC that there had been a change to a portion of ineligible services under the internet access/web hosting services heading that included making "intranet web hosting and/or password protected pages" eligible. We concluded that the 5% mentioned above was the same as "intranet web hosting and/or password protected pages".

The Manufacturer Products Division of USAC emailed us on April 30th 2009 to ask for more information regarding our 5% allocation referenced above. We responded to USAC and were informed that our services' eligibility, based on current FCC guidelines for internet access and Web Hosting, had not changed and that our clients would not be able to include the extra 5% in their applications to USAC.

SchoolFusion maintains that our description of "User Account Management aligned with permissions and account security" in the following paragraph is the same as "Intranet Web Hosting and/or Password protected pages" as it applies to our solution. We are hoping that this description is taken into consideration for our clients' benefit.

In order to use the portion of our web hosting solution that provides access for the applicant to upload and view the applicant provided content, the applicant must enter a designated password. Additionally, a separate username and password is
