To All:

According to the ALJs' Ruling of March 17, 2009, the parties were to conduct a conference call with the ALJs after a final order was entered in the Intrado-AT&T arbitration. Reading the Ruling broadly, the call would have occurred around May 11. The ALJs understand that this case may have moved to your respective back burners as you conduct arbitrations in other states and, perhaps, await FCC or appellate authority. Nonetheless, the clock continues on this arbitration and something must be done.

Please make contact with each other and either establish a consensus on a course of action or bring conflicting proposals to the ALJs' attention. Contact the ALJs by no later than 2pm (CDT) on Thursday, June 18 via email or telephone to generally report the results of your discussions and schedule a date for a formal

conference call or status hearing (at which out-of-town parties can participate by telephone). The ALJs are available to conduct the conference call/status hearing during the afternoon of June 25, the morning of June 26, or at most times during the week of June 29 (except for 6/30).
