

On Monday, June 29, 2009, I met with Pamela Arluk, Bill Cook, Lynne Engledow and Al Lewis of the Wireline Competition Bureau to discuss the above-captioned proceeding. The discussion focused on and was consistent with NewPhone's prior submissions in this docket. In addition, I indicated that incumbent LEC bundled services allocations must be in compliance with section 254(k). I also explained that the passage of time has made the need for a final Commission order on the pending petition more acute.
