Sky Com 700 MHZ, LLC (Sky Com) is the licensee of 700 MHz Band Station WQIZ629 (CMA486 – Minnesota 5 - Wilkin, Channel Block B). Sky Com's Auction 73 long-form application was granted by the Commission during the second quarter of 2008. See, *Public Notice*, entitled "Wireless Telecommunications Bureau Grants 700 MHz Band Licenses," DA 08-1521, Report No. AUC-73 (Auction No. 73), dated June 26, 2008.


Pursuant to Section 27.20 of the Commission's Rules, Sky Com hereby reports that, for the quarter ended June 30, 2009, it was not involved in outreach efforts to educate consumers about the transition from analog to digital broadcast television service (DTV transition).

However, one of the owners of membership shares of Sky Com, namely Gardonville Cooperative Telephone Association, that has a spectrum leasing arrangement with Sky Com involving station WQIZ629, has reported that it has sent monthly notices to its 700 MHz subscribers regarding the DTV transition.

In addition, to our knowledge, other owners of Sky Com that are recipients of federal USF funds, may have also been involved in such outreach efforts with respect to their wireline (including Lifeline and Link-Up) subscribers.
