Dear Chief Furth:

NPSPAC Region 28 RPC fully expected to be able to file their Non-Streamline plan Amendment by the July 10th Due date. However, due to circumstances beyond our ability to comply, we never received any of our formal requests for concurrence for our amended plan from any of our five adjacent regions.

So, we once again must beg the commission's favor and respectfully requests an additional 15 business day extension to be in full compliance with the Commission's rules to have adjacent region concurrence to be able to file the non-streamline amendment. The extra 15 business days is necessary to be able to physically reach out to the five adjacent Regions 8, 20, 30, 36, and 55 to implore them to review our 800 MHz Post Rebanding Plan and to provide written concurrence and approval to accompany our plan to the Commission.

Region 28 RPC will have a completed and amended plan with letters of concurrence from the five adjacent NPSPAC regions provided the Commission will grand an additional 15 business days extension to file our amendment plan.
