Buffalo City School District (Buffalo) respectfully requests, that the Commission review Universal Service Administrative Company's Schools and Libraries Division decisions denying funding for Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections services relative to Funding Request Numbers (FRNs) 1735675 and 1735678. This Request for Review and/or Waiver is made to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 54.719(c) and 54.721 and 47 C.F.R. §1.3 seeking relief relative to:

REASONS FOR APPEAL:

Buffalo City School District is appealing the funding denials for FY 2008-2009 FRNs 1735675 and 1735678 which were both denied funding by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) for the same reason. The Funding Commitment Decision Letter (FCDL) explanation for both FRNs stated: "DR1: The applicant's request to revise block 4 of the 471 application could not be processed because the request was not received within the required 15-day timeframe for receiving clerical and ministerial error corrections as stated in the FCC's [sic] Bishop Perry Order (FCC 06-54). As a result of the request being made outside of the allowable time, the discount will remain at 86%. DR2: Given Program demand, the funding cap will not provide for Internal

Connections and/or Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections at your approved discount level to be funded.” The funding denial was appealed to the SLD, which appeal was summarily denied in the Administrator’s Decision on Appeal Letter (ADAL) dated June 24, 2009. The SLD fundamentally restated the reasons given in the FCDL, only in greater detail, asserting:

Upon review of the appeal letter and the relevant documentation, USAC has determined that a Form 471 Receipt Acknowledgment Letter (RAL) was dated February 14, 2008, to Buffalo City School District (District). The RAL provided the District with the opportunity to make allowable corrections to any errors on your FCC Services Ordered and Certification Form 471. All corrections were due to USAC by March 5, 2008. On January 21, 2009, the District requested various Block 4 corrections. The request to correct the entities and the discounts were not received during the allowable timeframe to make corrections to the Form 471. Subsequently, a Funding Commitment Decision Letter (FDCL) was mailed on April 7, 2009. Hence the appeal is denied.

The applicant’s request to revise Block 4 of the Form 471 application could not be processed because the request was not received within the required 15-day timeframe for receiving clerical and ministerial error corrections as stated in the FCC’s Bishop Perry Order (FCC 06-54). As a result of the request being made outside of the allowable time, the discount will remain at 86%.

It is from the Administrator’s Decision on Appeal that this Request for Review and/or Waiver is brought before the Commission.

I. BACKGROUND

Buffalo City School District is a large urban school district with a significant number of low and moderate-income students that qualify for free and reduced price lunches through the U.S. Department of Agriculture’s National School Lunch Program. In February

2008 Buffalo filed Form 471 Application 628914 making requests for both Priority One and Priority Two services at a shared discount level of 86%. Included in this application was FRN 1735675 for Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections services from Erie 1 BOCES (SPIN 143019877) and FRN 1735678 for Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections services from Ronco Communication & Electronics, Inc. (SPIN 143005886).

On December 15, 2008, more than 10 months after Application 628914 was filed, Buffalo received a Program Integrity Assurance (PIA) review inquiry. Question II of the PIA asked questions about the multiple non-instructional facilities as they pertained to Buffalo's Priority Two Basic Maintenance FRNs. In the course of preparing its response to the PIA Buffalo discovered that it had unintentionally omitted ten non-instructional facilities ("NIFs") from Block 4 worksheet 1008780, including the omission of the crucial Network Operations Center. The ten NIFs had been inadvertently omitted when the Form 471 was prepared, which errors/omissions went completely unnoticed until the PIA review. Buffalo also first discovered that it had omitted from the Form 471 Block 4 worksheet, free and reduced data for eleven other instructional entities that were already on the worksheet. Now aware of the errors it had made in preparing Application #628914, Buffalo included in its response to PIA Question II a request to PIA reviewer, Chris Averill, to correct Block 4 worksheet 1008780 to add the ten omitted NIF entities and the omitted free and reduced data for the eleven other entities.¹

Since Application 628914 contained both Priority One and Priority Two service requests, adding the ten NIFs to worksheet 1008780 meant that there were now many

entities ineligible to receive Basic Maintenance services. Since most of its NIFs are not eligible for Priority Two Services, Buffalo asked Mr. Averill to create a second Block 4 worksheet and provided him the specific entities and associated free and reduced data to be included in the new worksheet. This request specifically indicated it was for Buffalo's Priority Two FRNs 1735675 and 1735678. Had this request for a second worksheet not had been made, the addition of the NIFs would have resulted in a request of Priority Two services for many non-qualifying entities. In turn, this would have led to funding being denied for Buffalo's two Basic Maintenance FRNs. Although Buffalo made the request for the creation of a new worksheet because of the large number of NIFs that were ineligible for Priority Two services, due to the fortuitously delayed timing of the PIA, Buffalo was aware that FY2008 funding for entities with 86% discounts was questionable and that the FCC had already approved applications with 88% discount levels for Priority Two services, so its new worksheet contained eligible entities that allowed the worksheet to have a shared discount of 88%. Buffalo did not do this to circumvent any E-rate program rules, but felt that creating the new worksheet with two (2) fewer eligible entities than worksheet 1008780 would allow the district to obtain Basic Maintenance services for its neediest schools.

II. DISCUSSION

A. SLD's Customary Practices and FCC Precedents Allow for Corrections To Applications During PIA

As described by Step 8 of the Applicant section of the USAC website, the purpose of a PIA review is "to verify the accuracy of discount percentages and ensure that support is

committed only for eligible products and services.”² Towards this goal USAC has always followed the practice of allowing schools to take corrective actions during the Program Integrity Assurance Review process. This is sometimes done at the request of the reviewer, sometimes done at the request of the applicant, and sometimes done in consultation between the reviewer and the applicant. Regardless of how the changes/corrections come to take place, the SLD has historically allowed proper corrections to be made to Form 471 applications during the PIA phase of application review. The types of corrections and changes that have been routinely permitted during PIA, include but are not limited to, entity removal, entity additions, corrections to free and reduced data, adjustments to funding request dollars, and, removal of ineligible services. Although the SLD denied funding for FRNs 1735675 and 1735678 stating that Buffalo’s request to revise Block 4 could not be processed because it was received too late, in a *USAC Administrator’s Decision on Appeal For Funding Year 2008-2009* for Espiritu Community Development Corp. (Application 6011233) issued a month *after* Buffalo’s request, it confirmed its own policy of allowing corrections during PIA by stating in the Decision on Appeal Explanation: “ Applicants can make data entry corrections, including increase in funding and discounts, during the Receipt Acknowledgement Letter (RAL) or PIA process.”³ When it asked for the creation of the new worksheet Buffalo did not seek any increased funding or services beyond the original amount sought on its Form 471 Application. Knowing the SLD’s long history of allowing these kinds of changes during PIA is what led Buffalo to submit its corrections and

modifications to its reviewer; the SLD's Espiritu decision confirms this was still their policy when Buffalo made its request. Further, the SLD did in fact process several of the corrections Buffalo requested despite the FCDL and ADAL explanations to the contrary. It is clear from the actions and statements made by the SLD that at the time Buffalo submitted its requests to its PIA reviewer the SLD's policy to allow data entry corrections was still in effect and that the SLD's claim that Buffalo's corrections were submitted outside the allowable timeframe is fallacious.

B. The Funding Denial Explanation is Inconsistent With The SLD's Actions and The Corrections Actually Made by the SLD During PIA to Form 471 628914.

Contrary to the explanation in both the FCDL and ADAL explanations stating that Buffalo's requested corrections could not be processed because they were received after the 15-day allowable timeframe, the revised Form 471 posted on the SLD's website clearly shows that corrections requested by Buffalo during PIA *were* processed. The current Form 471 application display for Application No. 628914 shows that the ten NIF entities and the discount percentages of the eleven other entities were added to original Worksheet No. 1008780; that the new Block 4 worksheet was created (assigned number 1074059) and was given a shared discount of 88%.⁴ Clearly, in keeping with its historical precedents, the SLD allowed Buffalo to utilize the PIA process to make corrections to its Form 471 application. In fact, it made all of the corrections that Buffalo had asked for; the only correction not made by the SLD was applying the new worksheet with its 88% discount level to the Block 5 Priority Two funding requests.

Requesting the creation of a second worksheet was not made belatedly or arbitrarily; it became necessary only after an accurate response to a PIA question resulted in NIFs being added to Worksheet No. 1008780. Asking Mr. Averill to amend original Block 4 Worksheet No. 1008780 to add the missing NIFs in turn necessitated asking for a second worksheet to be created for its Priority Two FRNs without the NIF entities. Had Buffalo been aware of the errors and omissions within the 15-day RAL period, it most certainly would have made the corrections at that time. However, Buffalo remained unaware that it had made mistakes or omitted entities and data until its PIA review, so making the corrections by March 5, 2008 was impossible.

Despite the FCDL & ADAL explanations, the SLD processed the corrections Buffalo requested to its Block 4. Since its PIA response stated that the new worksheet was being requested specifically for FRNs 1735675 and 1735678, Buffalo fails to understand how or why the SLD would create the new worksheet and then refuse to apply the worksheet to the Block 5 FRNs. The SLD's statements that the District's discount would remain at 86% because the corrections were not submitted within the allowable timeframe are unjustified. The changes that were actually made by the SLD to the Block 4 undermine the SLD's own FCDL and ADAL denial rationale which state that the requests to revise Block 4 of the application couldn't be processed because they were submitted outside the allowable correction period. This funding denial explanation in both the FCDL and ADAL is completely contradictory to the actual actions taken by the SLD in amending the 471 application, as verified by the current 471 display.

The Administrator's Decision on Appeal Letter was issued by the SLD on June 24, 2009, a mere two weeks after the appeal was filed. Although the arguments put forth herein were proffered in Buffalo's appeal to the SLD, the ADAL denial explanation allows for the inference that the SLD completely and summarily ignored all of the information and arguments that were submitted, including the fact that the SLD actually processed several of the corrections that it claimed were submitted outside the 15-day timeframe. In the ADAL the SLD merely reiterated its unreasonable and contradictory position as well as ignored its own statement to the contrary in the ADAL issued to Espiritu Community Development Corp. a month after Buffalo submitted its PIA requests. For these reasons the denial explanation in the ADAL is insufficient to justify the SLD's failure to apply the new worksheet to the Block 5 funding requests.

C. The Explanations in the FCDL and ADAL Do Not Allow Buffalo to Understand The Reasons for The SLD's Funding Denial

The FCC has already stated that a funding denial explanation should allow an applicant to be able to understand the rationale underlying the SLD's decision to deny funding.⁵ In light of the SLD making corrections to Buffalo's Form 471 application as requested in Buffalo's January 21, 2009 PIA response, the denial reasons in the FCDL and ADAL provide insufficient explanation and justification for SLD failing to make the additional change of applying the 88% worksheet to the Block 5 FRNs. While the words in the FCDL and ADAL are in themselves clear, the explanation provided is inconsistent with the SLD's actual actions as well as the SLD's statement in its Espiritu ADAL. Buffalo is unable to

reconcile how the SLD could say that it rejected the data and requests submitted during PIA for being submitted outside the allowable timeframe and yet at the same time acted to have processed them. The SLD's contradictory stance leaves Buffalo unable to comprehend the SLD's rationale and impedes its ability to adequately address the issue in this appeal.

D. Statement in Support of Waiver

If, in fact, although nowhere published by the SLD, the procedural rule stating that corrections of clerical and ministerial errors may no longer be made during PIA and may only be made within the RAL correction period, Buffalo hereby requests the FCC to grant it a waiver of the policy. In support of this request Buffalo avers that during the application process it complied with all substantive rules of the E-rate program. The corrections it requested to allow it to obtain an 88% discount level and thereby secure Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections services was not done to waste, abuse or defraud the E-rate program, but was done for the benefit of its more than 36,000 students. Buffalo applied for E-rate funds for these crucial Basic Maintenance services necessary to keep Buffalo's networks and internal connections equipment operational for the effective transport of data and information and will suffer hardship if denied E-rate funding for these services. Buffalo makes this request for waiver based on prior FCC precedent in which the Commission has stated:

The Commission may waive any provision of its rules on its own motion and for good cause shown. A rule may be waived where the particular facts make strict compliance inconsistent with the public interest. In addition, the Commission may take into account considerations of hardship, equity, or more effective implementation of overall policy on an individual basis. In sum, waiver is appropriate if special circumstances warrant a deviation from the general rule, and such deviation would

better serve the public interest than strict adherence to the general rule.
(footnotes omitted)⁶

The FCC has repeatedly reiterated its authority under 47 C.F.R. §1.3 to waive rules for good cause shown and has routinely waived compliance for violations when the record contains no evidence of intent to defraud or abuse the E-rate program and where the public interest is better serviced by granting a waiver. It is certainly in the best interests of the students of Buffalo City School District that if in fact there was a change in the SLD's procedural rules, that it be waived in this instance. If a waiver is not granted, it is the students of the District who will suffer the hardship that the SLD's failure to fund Buffalo's Priority Two Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections funding requests will bring. Therefore, should the FCC find that the procedural rule disallowing clerical and ministerial corrections to be made during PIA was in place, it will better serve the public interest, and the interests of Buffalo's student population, that the District be granted a waiver of the rule.


III. RELIEF REQUESTED

Buffalo requests the FCC grant its Request for Review asking that the FCC order the SLD to allow Buffalo to modify its Block 4 and Block 5 data so that Buffalo's neediest schools may obtain FY2008 E-rate funding for Basic Maintenance of Internal Connections Services. In the alternative, if the FCC does not grant Buffalo's Request For Review, that it grant a waiver to Buffalo allowing the aforementioned modifications and corrections be made regardless of any applicable timeframe to accomplish this goal. Buffalo further requests that the FCC remand Buffalo's application to USAC for further processing; instruct the SLD

to apply worksheet number 1074059 to FRNs 1735675 and 1735678; and instruct the SLD to modify the discount percentage for those FRNs to 88%, thereby allowing Buffalo to receive funding for Basic Maintenance Of Internal Connections Services for FY2008.

Here is our response to your PIA questions of 12/15/2008 regarding application 628914 for Buffalo City School District.

Please note, in preparing this response, we discovered clerical errors in our original submission of application #628914. This PIA response corrects those errors. The corrections are as follows.

Due to a clerical error the block 4 worksheet 1008780 incorrectly omitted some non-instructional entities, and incorrectly omitted free and reduced information for some instructional entities. The correct Block 4 information is shown below. Please note, worksheet 1008780 is no longer appropriate for FRNs 1735675 and 1735678. Please create a new worksheet with the entities shown in Table #2 which is found later in this response.

After these changes, worksheet 1008780 remains at 86% for Priority 1 FRNs. The newly created worksheet is 88% for priority 2 FRNs.

- Under FRN 1735675 there are 39,500 Cat5, Cat6 and Fiber drops which were included in the \$684,918.14 request.
- Under FRN 1735678 there is a portion of the maintenance which was accidentally omitted. The \$132,852.00 was for maintenance of common PBX equipment and did not include the cost of maintaining drops, moves, changes, configuration and testing which is an additional \$106,146.00. This increases the price for FRN 1735678 from \$132,852.00 to \$238,998.00. There are unrelated reductions which are detailed in Attachment C, so the net pre-discount request is \$223,871.54.
