Pursuant to paragraphs 45 and 60 of the International Bureau Order released on June 15, 2009 in the above-referenced proceeding (*See* Order and Request for Further Comment, IB Docket No. 09-10, rel. June 15, 2009, DA 09-1325), Verizon files this report concerning its attempts to have its circuits on the U.S.-Tonga route restored.

Verizon's circuits to Tonga remain blocked. A Verizon representative contacted Tonga Communications Corporation ("TCC"). He was told that, while TCC would like to re-open services with Verizon, they cannot proceed because of their regulatory mandate.
