MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULING ORDER

TCR Sports Broadcasting Holding, L.L.P., d/b/a Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (“MASN”), by its attorneys, respectfully requests to amend the post-trial scheduling Order in one regard. The views of the Enforcement Bureau are now due on July 31, 2009. MASN requests to extend this period by just one week, and have those views due on August 7, 2009.

MASN seeks this brief delay in order to advance the prospect of productive settlement negotiations. The parties recently have agreed to meet and discuss a possible resolution on August 4, 2009. Because the views of the Enforcement Bureau may add weight to the arguments of MASN or Comcast, they may hamper (and even undermine) those negotiations. Under these circumstances, a brief delay would cause no prejudice to any party, and may benefit the prospect of reaching a mutually agreeable settlement.

The Enforcement Bureau has authorized MASN to state that, on the Bureau’s behalf, it does not object to a one-week extension. Comcast has indicated that it opposes the extension.
