

Since the takeover of XM, Sirius has used the excuse of additional royalty fees for music as a thinly-veiled price increase. The actual charges per account are small, only cents per month. Indeed, for every \$100 in revenues, Sirius is being charged \$0.50 per month. That's about a nickel a month. Yet, Sirius is slapping a \$2.00 per month fee on each account, be it a Sirius account or an XM account. This is nothing more than a price hike in direct violation of the terms of the merger and I would call upon the FCC for immediately disallow it.
