In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. Section 1.1206, we hereby provide you with notice of an oral *ex parte* presentation in connection with the above-referenced proceeding. The presentation occurred on April 22, 2009 in a meeting with the Acting Bureau Chief and staff of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau: James Schlichting, Chris Moore, Nese Guendelsberger, Susan Singer, Won Kim and Christina Clearwater.

Attending the meeting on behalf of Cellular South, Inc. were David LaFuria and David Nace who suggested that the Commission promptly take action to extend the automatic roaming obligation to non-interconnected services. The Commission has legal authority to do so under any of Titles I, II and III of the Communications Act. Delay in action is detrimental to the interests of subscribers who have a reasonable expectation of access to their email, for example, when traveling and delay threatens the ongoing viability of small and mid-sized wireless carriers such as Cellular South, Inc.
