On Thursday, August 13, 2009, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, Scott Bergmann, Assistant Vice President, Regulatory Affairs and David Redl, Director, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA - The Wireless Association® met with Bruce Gottlieb, Chief Counsel and Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman Julius Genachowski and David Goldman, Acting Legal Advisor to the Chairman to discuss the value, competition and innovation in the U.S. wireless industry consistent with the attached documents. CTIA also reiterated some of the concrete proposals CTIA has previously submitted for the record to improve wireless broadband including a grant of CTIA's Tower Siting "Shot Clock" Petition, access to additional spectrum, and more efficient clearing of spectrum auctioned for CMRS.

Additionally, as recent press reports indicate that the Commission is circulating an item for the August Open Agenda Meeting on consumer protection, CTIA thought it would be illustrative to share with the Commission the consumer friendly changes to carrier policies that have occurred in the last 18 months. CTIA shared the attached chart during the meeting to inform the conversation.
