

Sirius XM has added a new monthly fee of \$1.98 on \$12.95 subscriptions (a 15%) increase, and claiming that the company is passing on the cost of statutorily required music royalty fees. However, those royalty fees are only 6.5%, and the FCC's merger ruling only allowed the company to pass on INCREASES in the royalty fees. The allowed increase is 0.5%. 0.5% would be \$0.06 on a monthly \$12.95 service. Sirius XM is violating the FCC merger ruling by increasing its costs far in excess of the allowed royalty fee increases. Please hold them accountable for their actions.
