
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 18, 2009, Doug Brandon and David LaFrance of TerreStar Networks Inc. ("TerreStar") and the undersigned, counsel to TerreStar, met with Julius Knapp, Ira Keltz, Bruce Romano, Geraldine Matise, Jamison Prime, and Nicholas Oros of the Office of Engineering and Technology concerning the above-referenced proceedings.

At the meeting, the TerreStar representatives described the successful launch of TerreStar-1 and TerreStar's plans for commercial service; inquired as to the timetable for action on the Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking; and touched briefly on arguments made in previous filings concerning shared use of the 2 GHz band and the reimbursement sought by Sprint for BAS relocation expenses.
