Maupin Broadcasting Company ("MBC"), by its counsel and pursuant to Section 1.415 of the Commission's Rules, hereby submits these comments in response to the *Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*, DA 09-1727 (rel. Aug. 3, 2009), issued in the above-captioned rulemaking proceeding.


MBC reiterates its interest in and support of the proposed allotment of Channel 244C2 at Maupin, Oregon. The proposed allotment should be adopted as it will serve the public interest by providing the community of Maupin with its first local transmission service. MBC pledges to provide that first local service and, to that end, has applied on FCC Form 301 for an original construction permit for Channel 244C2 at Maupin (FCC File No. BNPH-20081107AEN). If the proposed allotment is adopted, MBC intends to apply to participate in the auction for the channel and, if the successful bidder, to promptly construct the station.


