On Tuesday, August 25, 2009, Alan Fishel on behalf of Sunesys and the undersigned on behalf of PCIA–The Wireless Infrastructure Association and The DAS Forum met with Julie Veach, Marcus Maher and Marvin Sacks of the Wireline Competition Bureau and Tom Koutsky of the Office of Strategic Planning.

In this meeting we discussed the Broadband Wireless Pole Attachment Coalition's proposal, submitted on February 23, 2009, to establish definitive timeframes for the pole attachment make-ready process. The parties focused on subsequent filings in response to that document. Additionally, the parties emphasize the need for the FCC to develop a make-ready timeline given the delays inherent in the pole attachment process and importance of pole attachments to broadband deployment.
