

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Katherine Pyeatt ("Pyeatt"), permittee for Station KKLB(FM), Channel 267A, Madisonville, Texas hereby submits this Petition for Rule Making. In a simultaneously filed application, Pyeatt is filing to change the channel of KKLB from Channel 267A to Channel 299A at Madisonville, Texas.¹ In order to accomplish this change, Pyeatt requests, in this Petition for Rule Making, that the Commission substitute Channel 278A for vacant Channel 299A at Buffalo, Texas and substitute Channel 267A for vacant Channel 278A at Centerville, Texas.² In support hereof, Pyeatt states as follows:

The two vacant channel substitutions proposed in this Petition for Rule Making will allow KKLB to move from Channel 267A to Channel 299A at a tower site located closer to its city of license, Madisonville, Texas. Thus, this proposal as a whole serves the public interest.

¹ Pyeatt has filed a Form 301 Application (with the requisite fee) seeking the channel substitution for Station KKLB-FM.

² Pursuant to the Commission's new allotment procedures, "changes to vacant allotments will continue to be made via notice-and-comment rule making procedures." See *Revision of Procedures Governing Amendments to FM Table of Allotments and Changes of Community of Licenses in the Radio Broadcast Services*, 21 FCC Rcd 1412, (2006). Thus, this proposal is considered a hybrid filing.


As demonstrated in the attached engineering, Channel 278A can be allotted to Buffalo consistent with Section 73.207 of the Commission's Rules. A 70 dBu signal can be provided to Buffalo from the proposed reference coordinates, 31-21-08.6 N/ 95-59-46.7 W. (See, Attachment A)

Also as demonstrated in the attached engineering, Channel 267A can be allotted to Centerville consistent with Section 73.207 of the Commission's Rules. A 70 dBu signal can be provided to Centerville from the proposed reference coordinates, 31-14-17 N/ 96-05-34 W. (See, Attachment B)

Accordingly, in order to allot Channel 299A to Madisonville, Texas for use by KKLBB-FM, Pyeatt respectfully requests that the Commission substitute Channel 278A for vacant Channel 299A at Buffalo, Texas and substitute Channel 267A for vacant Channel 278A at Centerville, Texas as proposed herein.

The factual information provided in this Petition for Rule Making is correct and true to the best of my knowledge.






