Yesterday Steven Zipperstein, Vice President – Legal & External Affairs and General Counsel of Verizon Wireless, and the undersigned, met with Edward P. Lazarus, Bruce Liang Gottlieb and Priya Aiyar of Chairman Genachowski's office. Mr. Zipperstein discussed Verizon Wireless's July 22, 2009 letter to the Honorable Henry Waxman, Chairman, House Energy and Commerce Committee, supporting a new statute or FCC rule governing home roaming if it applied to all carriers. (The letter was previously filed in these dockets on July 23, 2009.) Mr. Zipperstein reiterated the company's position as set forth in the letter that the Commission should reject efforts to require in-market roaming on an individual carrier basis.
